2. Best moved to accept the Proclamation naming February as Black History Month in Villa Rica, seconded by Amidon. Carried 5/0.
3. Holland moved to appoint Mike Gill to the Planning and Zoning Commission for the 2-1-2008 to 1-31-2009 term, seconded by Amidon. Carried 5/0.
4. Best motioned to approve the appointment of Deborah Holland and the reappointment of Bill Taylor to the Downtown Development Authority's board, seconded by Amidon. Carried 4/1 with Holland abstaining.
5. Kelley moved to approve ABL-01-08, an application for pouring license by Tash Tasova for Olive Tree Restaurant, 150 Stone St., seconded by Holland. Carried 4/1 with Marchman opposing.
6. Kelley moved to approve ABL-02-08, an application by Anwar Sharif for the sale of packaged beer/wine at Liberty Shell Food Mart, 10135 Hwy 78E, Douglas Co., seconded by Best. Carried 4/1 with Marchman opposing.
7. Amidon moved to approve RA-01-08, a request by Chuck Willoughby to rezone ±1.05ac at 8 Stockmar Rd from R-20 to GC for the purpose of a fruit stand, seconded by Holland. Carried 5/0.
8. Marchman moved to approve CU-01-08 a request by Sam and Ada Large for conditional use of 105 W Church St for the purpose of a church with the stipulation that the conditional use expires in one year, seconded by Holland. Carried 5/0.
9. Kelley moved to approve CU-02-08 a request by Tyler Brown for conditional use of 159 Liberty Rd for the purpose of a church with the five conditions recommended by P&Z and with the conditional use expiring in five years, seconded by Best. Carried 5/0
